## **Discipline:**

- + Discipline is the sine qua non of any successful academic life. The training emphasizes on strict and positive discipline so as to inoculate among the teacher trainees the desirable habits required of a good teacher. Thus they in their turn will be able to instill among children the habits of courtesy, regularity, co-operation, cleanliness, consideration to others, cheerfulness, devotion and duties etc.
- + Every student must attend the prayer and assembly every day.
- + At least 80%(Theory Class) and 90%(Practical Class) attendance must to appear in the final examination.
- + The students are required to submit medical certificates from a medical practitioner (above 3 days) along with a letter of guardian if sick, stating clearly the cause and length of absence.
- + No student is allowed to leave the institution before the day's work is over. Special permission from the Principal may be obtained by the student wanting to leave earlier by producing a letter from her/guardian.
- + Students are expected to maintain proper discipline and in necessary decorum in the classroom, in the office, in the play ground, in the campus.
- + No outsiders / friends are allowed to meet the students during class hours.
- + The assignments given by each lecturer must be completed and submitted by the students on the exact date by the respective lectures.
- + Admit cards, mark sheets and certificates will not be handed over to guardians or others only bonafide students can collected these important documents from the college office.

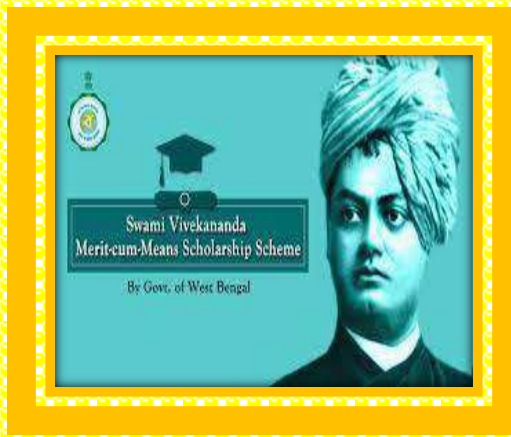
